

## Thanksgiving Fun with AP Containers

1. Use Small Square Plastic Containers (#4435) to mark everyone's place at the Thanksgiving table. Fill with "Blessing Mix" and attach a name card and Blessing Mix tag. (Printable tag is available at [www.alisonspantry.com](http://www.alisonspantry.com).)

### **BLESSING MIX RECIPE:**

2 cups Bugles  
2 cups pretzels  
1 cup raisins (#5440) or other dried fruit  
1 cup candy corn  
1 cup sunflower seeds (#3960) or peanuts (#3975)  
1 cup M&M's  
Hershey's chocolate kisses

Combine all ingredients and scoop into containers, placing 1 Hershey's Kiss in each container.

2. Help your customers to think about the importance of food storage and preparedness with this thoughtful Thanksgiving gift. Fill one of our 16 oz. plastic containers (#5128) with Dehydrated Corn (#1962). Attach a tag that says:

"This Thanksgiving, feel greater gratitude as you honor the custom of the early Pilgrims. Place 5 kernels of corn on each dinner plate, and share the thought below. You can then have each guest at the table share 5 things for which they are grateful, if desired. Add the remaining dehydrated corn in the container to your next Corn Chowder!

"The first Winter the Pilgrims spent in their new home was bitterly cold. Food was in short supply. Some days they had only enough food for each person to have five kernels of corn for the day. Finally spring came. They planted food and it grew. Many Pilgrims survived. From then on, when a time of Thanksgiving came around, the Pilgrims put five kernels of corn on each plate to remind themselves of their blessings.

- The first kernel reminds us of the autumn beauty around us.
- The second kernel reminds us of our love for each other.
- The third reminds us of God's love and care for us.
- The fourth kernel reminds us of our friends.

### **TURKEY NOODLE SOUP MIX RECIPE:**

#### **FOR CONTAINER:**

1 c. uncooked egg noodles  
1 1/2 Tbsp. chicken bouillon  
1/8 tsp. ground black pepper  
1/4 tsp. ground whole thyme  
1/8 tsp. celery seed  
1/8 tsp. garlic powder  
1 bay leaf

#### **FOR TAG:**

1 container Turkey Noodle Soup Mix  
8 cups water  
2 carrots, diced  
2 stalks celery, diced  
1/4 c. minced onion  
3 c. cooked diced turkey

Combine the Mix and water in large stock pot. Add vegetables and bring to boil. Reduce heat, cover and cook for about 15 minutes. Discard the bay leaf and stir in cooked turkey. Simmer for 5 minutes more. Serve.
